Graduating Students Google Data Transfer

Graduating students have the ability to copy Gmail and Drive data from their @stu.palmbeachschools.org account to a consumer @gmail.com account. However, data transfers must be initiated by June 11 in order to be completed before graduating seniors' accounts are deactivated. Once the accounts are deactivated, the ability to transfer data will no longer be available.

Start the copy process:

- 1. On your school account, go to Transfer your content.
- 2. Enter the email address of the Google Account where you want to copy your content.
- 3. Select Get Code.
- 4. On your Google Account, check your Gmail inbox for a confirmation email from Google. In the email, select Get confirmation code. A new tab will open with a code. 5. On your school account, go back to the "Transfer your content" page. Enter the code, then choose Verify.
- 6. Choose the content you would like to copy, then select Start transfer.

Deadline to Indicate a Free AP Score Report Recipient

June 20 is the deadline for students to indicate the recipient of their free AP score report through My AP. Students may indicate one college, university, or scholarship program to receive a free copy of their AP score report. To do this, students must:

- 1. Sign in to My AP.
- 2. Go to My AP Profile.
- 3. Click the Score Send tab.
- 4. Enter the college, university, or scholarship program, select it, and click Save.

Students can request a score report be sent to additional recipients for a fee. Details about sending additional score reports are in the Scores section on the <u>AP Students website</u>.


