  - SouthTech Academy Highlights
    - 878 Industry Certifications at STA
      - most we have ever earned (led PBC and state of Florida)
    - 100% Acceleration from CTE standpoint at STA
      - Every senior earned at least 1 industry certification
      - Highest percentage STA has ever had
    - Successful implementation of Cyber Security aspects within our IT academy
      - Security Fundamentals certification led to us obtaining more IT certs than ever before
      - Adding Web Security this year as we continue to follow the cyber security trends
      - Instructor earned more certifications than previous 2 instructors combined
  - SouthTech Preparatory Highlights
    - 150 Industry Certifications at STP
      - Earned over 3 times more industry certifications last year than year prior
      - STEM Academy performed better than majority of high school programs who offer STEM certification (84% passing rate overall and 95% in higher level classes)

  - Planning a visit with WPTV to make sure we are following latest trends
  - Exposure and MAKE IT FUN!!
    - Added a Film Appreciation elective for all students to bring awareness/exposure to our amazing film area

  - IT Academy
    - FDOE has revamped what industry certifications look like within IT
      - FDOE deleted the certification we were offering last year
      - New instructor is in process of getting certified in HTML/Coding (latest trend)

    - Not to outgrow our current room
      - Due to the room being converted into kitchen/cook space, it limits amount of students we can have in a classroom due to district protocols
      - Great problem to have but something we need to keep an eye so we don't lose our current enrollment momentum
