The program aims to leverage the diverse Air Force Junior ROTC cadet population, which is 43% female and 57% minority, to help address the predicted need for 6,000 - 8,000 pilots per year for the next 20 years across industry and the U.S. military.</p> <p>Cadets will attend private pilot training at public/private universities throughout the U.S. over the summer months for approximately 8 weeks. Student costs are minimal.
